2013 Out-of-State Teacher Scholarship Application

Scholarships from the Minnesota Department of Education are available for Minnesota public and non-public teachers attending 2013 out-of-state Advanced Placement training. The school or district will be responsible for the initial cost of the training. The district will be reimbursed up to \$1,000 for tuition, room and board, and travel.

Complete and mail this application form to: Jacqui McKenzie, Minnesota Department of Education, 1500 Highway 36 West, Roseville, MN 55113, by **May 24, 2013**. You will receive an email from MDE regarding your scholarship application within five (5) days of receipt.

Receipts for registration, room and board, and travel must be sent to MDE within 10 days of course completion, to qualify for reimbursement to the district/school; however, payment is not guaranteed until original receipts are received and attendance is verified.
