Subject: Application available for **Special Education Parent and Family Training Grant Opportunity - Due Date Extended**

The purpose of this federal CFDA 84.027A, Special Education- Grants to States funding is to develop and provide training to parents and family member of children birth – grade 5 with identified disabilities and developmental delays who are at risk for poor literacy outcomes. Applications will focus on at least one of four priority areas outlined in the instructions section.

The funding period is anticipated to be July 15, 2012, through June 30, 2013. Funding available for this initiative is \$125,000 to fund approximately eight projects up to \$15,625 each.

Applications due: ~~April 25~~, **May 4, 2012, Midnight, Central Time.**
